**The American Society of Head and Neck Radiology
Presents 2018 Gold Medal to Roy A. Holliday, M.D., during 52nd Annual Meeting**

The American Society of Head and Neck Radiology (ASHNR) awarded its 2018 Gold Medal to **Roy A. Holliday, M.D.**, during the Gold Medal Award Luncheon on September 28, 2018 during the ASHNR 52nd Annual Meeting at Westin Savannah Harbor Golf Resort and Spa in Savannah, Georgia, September 26-30, 2018.

The ASHNR Gold Medal is presented annually to a member who has provided dedicated service to the Society, and to the science and education of head and neck radiology. Dr. Holliday became the twenty-second recipient of the ASHNR Gold Medal since the Awards inception in 2000.

Dr. Holliday received his M.D. degree from New York University School of Medicine. He completed his postgraduate training in Diagnostic Radiology at NYU in 1986. From 1987 through 2002, he served as Director of Head and Neck Imaging at NYU. Dr. Holliday was the Director of Radiology at New York Eye and Ear Infirmary from 2002 until his retirement this past June. Dr. Holliday served as President of the ASHNR in 2005-2006.
