About The ASHNR

The American Society of Head and Neck Radiology (ASHNR) is a professional, non-profit, medical society comprised of over 1000 physicians and other health care providers with an interest in imaging and pathology of the head and neck. Founded in 1976, the ASHNR has a strong academic mission, providing intensive educational programming and promoting research in the field of head and neck imaging.

About The ASHNR Annual Meeting

The ASHNR annual meeting is the premier national event for head and neck imaging and will be held in Scottsdale, Arizona from October 2 - 6, 2019. There will be over 100 invited lecturers and moderators who are leaders in the field as well as in their practice settings. The 2018 meeting in Savannah, Georgia drew over 500 registrants.

The wide range of radiologists represented at the meeting includes specialists in adult and pediatric neuroradiology, head & neck imaging, emergency radiology and pediatric radiology, as well as a substantial number of general radiologists. The 53rd annual meeting will include integrated “value added” sessions encompassing various anatomic regions, imaging modalities and disease processes from infancy through adulthood, as well as a series of lectures designated as “core curriculum” that will cover more basic topics. The program this year will also include a focus on education and mentoring of trainees and junior faculty. SAM sessions will help registrants meet the ABR recertification requirements, a proven meeting “draw”. Scheduled refreshment breaks as well as Wednesday evening’s Opening Reception will be held in the technical exhibits area, allowing multiple opportunities for registrants to engage with exhibitors. All sessions and breaks occur on the ground level with immediate adjacency.

The Westin Kierland Resort and Spa, located near the McDowell Mountains in Scottsdale, AZ, is accessible from all major cities by direct flights to Sky Harbor International Airport, Phoenix, and located 20 miles from the airport. Adjacent to the resort are abundant dining, retail and entertainment options. The resort houses over 700 guestrooms and impressive, functionally effective meeting space. Exhibitors will be housed in the 5700 square foot Culturekeepers Hall West that is directly outside and on the same level as the Grand Ballroom, and adjacent to the outdoor patio. The resort features the Kierland Golf Club with 27 holes of Scott Miller-designed golf, the Agave Spa, a 24 hour fitness studio, swimming pools and several excellent restaurants. Known as “The City in the Valley of the Sun”, Scottsdale and nearby Phoenix offer a wealth of activities including innumerable hiking trails, hot air ballooning and a variety of museums. We hope that you will join us at this outstanding medical societal event.
